Code of Conduct for Children & Young Players

Children / Young Players with Newry City AFC are expected to:

- Behave and listen to all instructions from the coach.
- Keep within the defined boundary of the playing/coaching area.
- Take care of equipment owned by the Club
- Refrain from the use of bad language, racial or sectarian references
- Refrain for bullying or persistent use of rough and dangerous play
- Show respect to other players, coaches and volunteers
- Keep themselves safe
- Report inappropriate behaviour or risky situations for young people
- Play fairly
- Respect officials and accept decisions
- Show appropriate loyalty and be gracious in defeat
- Respect opponents and not cheat
- Not use violence.

Children / Young Players with Newry City AFC have a right to:

- Be safe and listened to
- Be respected
- Privacy
- Enjoy your football in a protective environment
- Be referred to professional help if needed
- Be protected from abuse by other members or outside sources
- Participate on an equal basis appropriate to their ability
- Be believed when asked for help

Any misdemeanours and general misbehaviour will be addressed by the immediate Coach/Volunteer and reported verbally to the designated person. Persistent misbehaviour may result in dismissal from the club. Parents will be informed. Dismissals can be appealed by the child/parent with final decision being taken by the Management Committee.
